

EJECTIONS. The following ejection policy has been approved and implemented by the CCS Board of Managers in 2006:

1. **first game ejection** for (misconduct or Flagrant Misconduct) player sits out a minimum of 1 game (league sometimes require two)
2. player any **subsequent game ejection** for misconduct in the same season—must sit out three games each time.
3. **second Flagrant Misconduct** game ejection on a player, that player is disqualified for the season.
4. When a **coach receives a yellow card**, he/she must remain seated on the team bench for the remainder of that game.
5. **Coach receives a red card** in a game, he has to leave the premises.
6. Coach receives **second red card** in a season, he is disqualified for the remainder of the season.
7. League policies are followed for appeals of game ejections.

**CCS WATER POLO CHAMPIOSHIPS,
EJECTION POLICY (10-16-2008)
SPORTSMANSHIP:**

It is essential that all competition be completely within the bounds of **GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP**. Therefore, any player or coach who is disqualified from a Play-off contest for **flagrant misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior** shall be disqualified from all remaining contests in that sport that season.
